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#### The Montfortian Consecration

Where can we find the teaching of Louis-Marie Grignion de Montfort (1673-1716) on the "consecration"? To find it, one must go to the sources and works of Montfort. By reading this, especially his three major works: the Love of Eternal Wisdom (LEW), the Secret of Mary (SM) and the Treatise on True Devotion to the Blessed Virgin (TD).

In the context of Montfort's teaching, the word "consecration" is used first and foremost to describe the Triune God's activity. Here is the meaning: "consecration" is an act of God for us, it is God who consecrates and sanctifies by communicating to us his holiness. In practice, this happens at baptism, which makes us holy temple of the Holy Trinity. And God continues to do so, without stopping, now and always, by the Holy Spirit. Then, on the human side, the word "consecration" is used by Montfort, in the active-receptive sense, so to say a man who collaborates actively, constantly and interiorly - by the sanctifying grace of God - to live truly in holiness that which exists in him since from his baptism.



So, to facilitate the effectivity of God's work in me, I must "consecrate myself", that I have to "surrender myself" with all that I have, to Jesus Christ through the hands of Mary, as a flexible and shapable or mouldable material, to be transformed by the Holy Spirit and truly become a son (or daughter) of the heavenly Father. In the prayer of consecration, we say to the Virgin Mary: "I surrender and consecrate myself to you ..." (LEW 225). As we note, the word "to consecrate" is paralleled by Montfort with the word "surrender". It's the same thing: a total willingness from my part to cooperate with God in order to realize his plan for myself or for others in history.

For this we quote the Secret of Mary (SM 28) that tells us that the perfect practice of true devotion to Mary consists in « surrendering oneself in the manner of a slave to Mary, and to Jesus through her, and then performing all our actions with Mary, in Mary, through Mary, and for Mary ». In this explanation, we find two principal ideas of consecration: the first, "surrendering oneself in the manner of a slave to Mary, and to Jesus through her"; the second, "performing all our actions with Mary, in Mary, through Mary, and for Mary".



If we develop these two dimensions of the consecration, we will join the TD 227-233 which presents the preparation for the consecration with its renewals, then the TD 121 which exposes the list of the things to consecrate and finally the TD 257-265 which contains "some very sanctifying interior practices for those souls who feel called by the Holy Spirit to a high degree of perfection." To be more informed about the "Montfortian consecration", one can read its theological foundation (TD 134-182), its traces in the tradition (TD 159-163); his exterior practices (TD 226-256), interior practices (TD 257-265) and practices in the Holy Communion (VD 266-273) and finally its impressive fruits (TD 213-225).
