Celebration of the Tercentenary in Denmark

SORÖ, Denmark - On the first Monday of the month, the International Day of Prayer (Montfortain aujourd'hui 130, 33-34), the members of the Montfortian association "Mary, Queen of All Hearts" which is composed of approximately 30 persons living in Denmark hold their monthly meeting. Not all of the members can attend regularly the monthly meeting because the venue is very far from their residences. For some it's nearly a hundred kilometers, not to mention the member from the Faroe Islands.
