

ANNIVERSARY OF CANONIZATION

On July 20, 1947,
in St. Peter's Basilica, Rome,
the solemn canonization
of St. Louis Marie de Montfort
took place:

*"In honour of the
Holy and Indivisible Trinity [...],
after the invocation
of divine help [...]
We declare and define
that must be held for saint [...]
the Blessed
Grignon de Montfort." (Pius XII)*



SPEECH OF POPE PIUS XII

The following is the speech of Pope Pius XII to the pilgrims gathered in Rome for the canonization of Saint Louis-Marie Grignion of Montfort, which happened on Monday, July 21, 1947:

"Dear sons and daughters, remain faithful to the precious legacy of this great saint! Magnificent heritage, it's worth that you continue, as you have done so far, to dedicate to it, to sacrifice to it without counting your strengths and your life! Show yourself as the heirs of his tender love for the humble of the smallest people, of his charity for the poor, remembering that he tore bread from his mouth to feed them, that he stripped himself of his clothes to cover their nakedness, the heirs of his solicitude for the children, privileged of his heart, as they were of the heart of Jesus.

The charity! here is the great secret, let's say the only secret of the surprising results of the life so short, so multiple and so hectic of Louis-Marie Grignion de Montfort: Charity! for you too, be intimately convinced of it, the strength, the light, the blessing of your existence and all your activity

The Cross of Jesus and the Mother of Jesus are the two poles of his personal life and his apostolate. And this is how this life, in its brevity, was full, how this apostolate, exercised in Vendée, in Poitou, in Brittany during hardly a dozen years, is perpetuated for already more than two centuries and extends on many regions."


Father Luizinho: Call to Holiness

The Superior General of the Montfort Missionaries, who is also the International Director of the Magazine, "Association Mary, Queen of All Hearts" has just delivered a video message on the 71st anniversary of the canonization of Saint Louis-Marie de Montfort, on 20th July 2018. Our Holy Missionary and founder was canonized on July 20, 1947 by Pius XII. In his message on the occasion of this anniversary, Father Luizinho reminds us of our vocation to holiness. Here is the text of this message.

"My dear brothers, my friends, on the celebration of the anniversary of the canonization of Saint Louis-Marie de Montfort, I would like to remind you that our vocation is that of holiness. We are called to become saints.

The General Chapter of 2017 has invited us to respond to the challenges of ongoing conversion because we are convinced that God's passionate love for us is the heart, the very foundation of our religious life. When we welcome God's love and live it in community our spiritual experience and fraternal life form a union that cannot be separated.

The invitation that arises from the anniversary of his canonization this year is to improve human relations in our communities and then in our missions. The testimony of a joyous community life in the reality of the



interculturality we live will always be the best way to attract new vocations. This testimony of the interculturality which is ours will also stimulate the laity to continue faithfully to walk on the path of holiness proposed by the Montfortian spirituality.


