



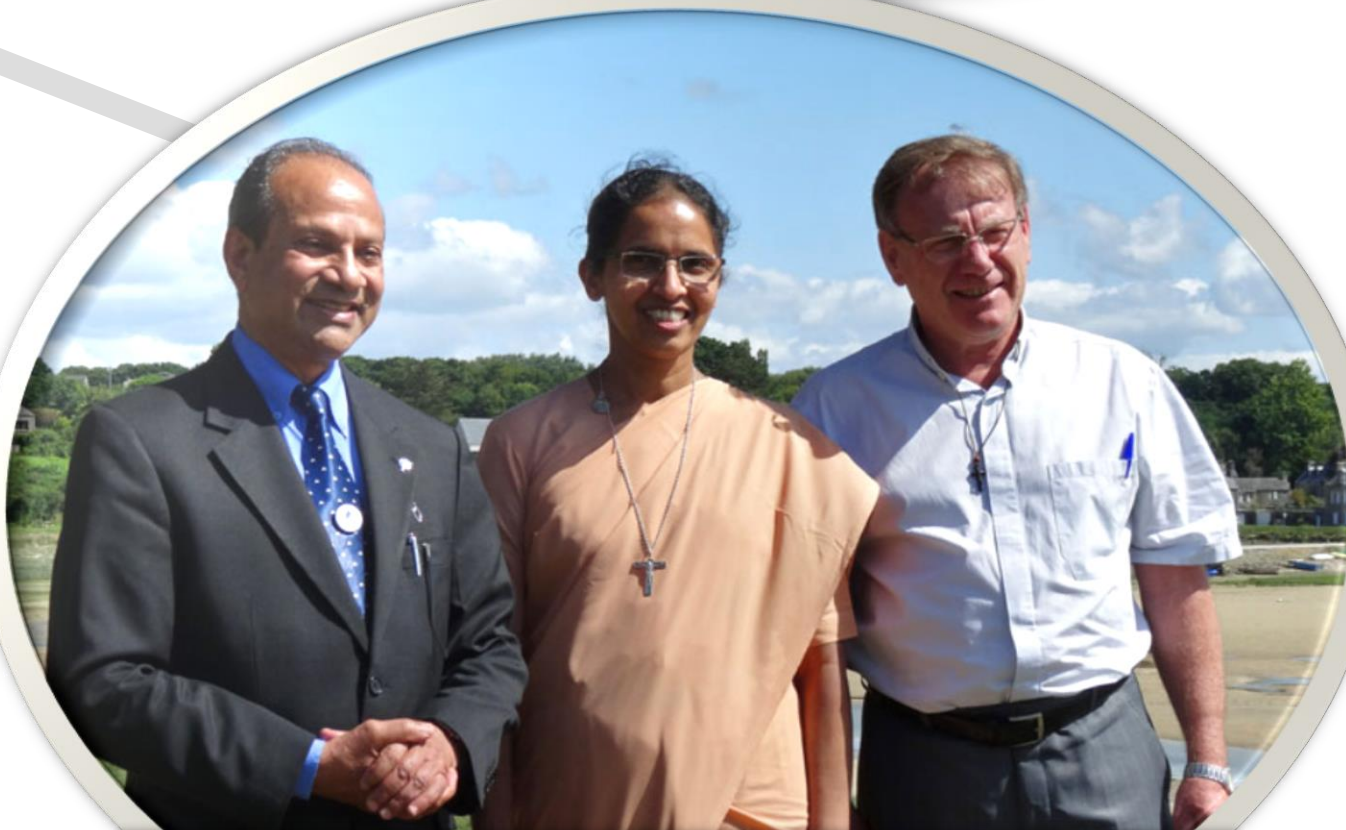

# Madagascar

## Montfortian Lay Associates

From August 1st to 18th, I visited Madagascar. During the visit, Father Bruno KIKY RANDRIANASOLO, the Provincial, presented to me the appointments already prepared with Montfortian lay associates in three different places.

The first was in Tamatave. The meeting was held on Sunday, August 12, in the parish church of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, under the coordination of Fr. Paul RAZAFITSIAROVANA. Nearly 30 members attended this meeting. They came from three different churches: Saint Theresa, the Sacred Heart and John XXIII.



The second meeting was held in Brickaville. The meeting was held on August 15th, under the coordination of Fr Jean Claude RAMANDRAIVONONA. The members present were 22 persons; they all came from Brickaville itself and Maromamy.



The third meeting was held in Antananarivo on August 17. Some 20 members came from Antsobolo and Andraisoro. According to information, currently Antsobolo has about 40 members under the direction of Fr. Crescent R.

RAFAMANTANANTSOA; while in Andraisoro, dozens of members are assisted by Father Jean-Baptiste RAKOTOARISOA and Brother François de Sales RANDRIANASOLO.



At each meeting, we exchanged information and shared our experiences. One of the challenges of Montfortian lay associates in Madagascar is the formation towards the consecration to Jesus Christ through Mary: to ensure that each member deeply assimilates this experience and implements it. Fr. Jean Claude RAMANDRAIVONONA, National Spiritual Director of the Montfortian lay associates, will coordinate with the other spiritual directors of each city.

In general, in Madagascar, the Montfort Missionaries are enthusiastic about sharing Montfortian spirituality with and through these brothers and sisters, lay associates. Next year, with the Brothers of St. Gabriel and the Daughters of Wisdom, there will be a biennial meeting of lay associates of these three Montfortian Congregations in Tamatave.

## TOTUS TUUS JOURNEY launched in Dalaguete, Cebu, Philippines

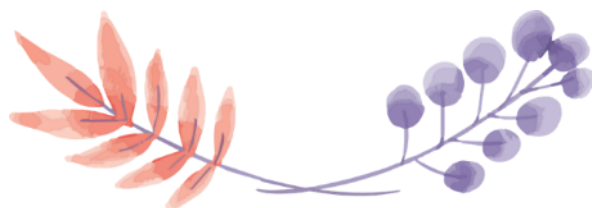

## Fraternity of Mary Queen of All Hearts in Togo

Message from **Mr Ernest Bida**,  
head of the provisional office  
for the coordination of Fraternity in Togo, August 13, 2018

*"I will say that the first consecration to my knowledge here in our country was made on May 13, 2000. It was on a secondary station, Holy Spirit of Totsi, now a parish. A dozen people, I was one of them, had made the consecration after a path of preparation during 33 days. The initiative was born from the then principal catechist, Laurent AKPEGNON.*

*It was one or two years later that the Legion of Mary, of which we were a member, took the idea and began to propagandize the consecration and invite people to do it, mainly legionaries. This began to spread on the parishes. To this day, I will say that many parishes in Lome do it. We do not have the exact numbers. It is with the visit of Brother Ignace MESSINO SMM that we started a coordination work"*

## Youth Pilgrimage of the Diocese of Toledo (Spain)

*From the 6th to the 13th of July, a group of more than 200 young people from the Diocese of Toledo (Spain), accompanied by 12 priests, made a pilgrimage to the Vendée with the desire to know the testimony of the martyrs of the XVIII century and to get acquainted with Saint Louis-Marie Grignon of Montfort, whose tomb is in the Basilica of Saint Laurent sur Sèvre.*
