During the exchange of peace, some of them offered white roses to the Italian parishioners as Filipinos celebrate the Holy Mass not without flowers... In the end, the parish priest, Father Luigi Colleoni, SMM thanked everyone and was hopeful that this cordial and pleasant meeting around the altar of the Lord will be repeated in the future in which no one is a stranger.
