

## TTJ Batch 15 Consecration in Cebu, Philippines

**CEBU**, Philippines – On April 29, 2018, eleven participants successfully completed the 33-day preparation for the Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary and had their consecration at the Montfort Mission House. They comprised the TTJ Batch 15 in Cebu. The group gathers at the Montfort Mission House in Minglanilla, Cebu for 33 Sundays.

The Holy Eucharist was presided by Rev. Fr. Richard J. Magararu, SMM, Delegation Superior and with concelebrants, Rev. Fr. Sherwin Y. Nunez, SMM, and Rev. Fr. Rene S. Bustillo, SMM.
