

## **Entrance to the Pre-Postulancy and Postulancy Programs 2021-2022**

philosophy. Before the homily, they were called to stand in front to be presented and to be asked by Rev. Fr. Santiago T. Casing, SMM.

The homilist, Rev. Fr. Sherwin Nuñez, SMM said that our journey as aspiring religious is not easy. There would be dying to oneself, making a lot of sacrifices. He also invited us to ponder upon the words of our Founder, Saint Louis-Marie de Montfort, "*If you don't take risk for God, you won't do great things for him"*.
