- To have **Montfortian Retreat** to continue our spiritual journey with the whole Montfortian Family.
- An **International Level Symposium** inviting eminent speakers to enlighten and enrich our spirituality and mission.
- An Audiovisual Presentation of the History of the Montfortian presence in India and the publication of the Souvenir to mark the Golden Jubilee year.
- We also plan to organize **The Marian Pilgrimages** to mark the Jubilee year with the spirit of Mother Mary.
- And finally, we planned to have a simple, yet solemn Golden Jubilee Celebration in the month of November 2023.
